To All Windows XP Users;

As you may already know, on April 8, 2014 Microsoft stopped all support and security updates for the Windows XP operating system. This means there is substantial risk to anyone still using this operating system. Windows will no longer update or support your XP system. If you are currently using Windows XP, please be aware that it is not considered safe to use an XP machine on the internet.

Because we want all of our customers to have the best and most secure Online Banking experience, we are in the process of upgrading our Online Banking System. All of the same great features will be there, but they will be better and more secure than ever.

With this upgrade comes security enhancements that require you to be on the latest version of whatever Internet Web Browser (Internet Explorer, Chrome, Firefox, etc) that you may be using. This will be a problem for Windows XP users because XP is unable to run the latest versions of these Web Browsers. This means that in order to use our Online Banking System, you will either have to use a different computer, or possibly upgrade your computer to a more current operating system with a secure browser.

- **After May 3, 2016, if you are using Windows XP, you will not be able to access our Online Banking System.**
